





Standard Pillowcase







Measurements:



Materials:

- 1,7m X 115cm (17/8 yards X 45 inches) Cotton fabric (Makes x2 pillowcases)
- Thread in complimentary colour


List of Pattern Pieces:

• 1: Pillowcase

Notes:

- The amount of fabric given makes 2 standard pillow cases.
- Finished pillow case size = $47 \text{ cm X } 70 \text{ cm } (18,5" \times 27,5")$
- Standard pillow size = 45cm X 70cm (18" x 27,5")
- If you want to make a pillowcase with two different fabrics for the front and back, separate the pattern on the line between the front and back.

Pattern Layout:



Instructions:

1) Pattern:

• Cut out pattern and transfer the markings.

2) Finish edges:

• Fold edge twice 1.5cm (5/8") (total 3cm (1 1/4") and stitch close to the seam edge. Repeat with the other side.

3) Stitch pillow:

- Fold RS of the back to the RS of the front, aligning at the overlap line (your pillow front and back are RS together).
- Next fold the RS of the overlap back onto the WS of the back.
- Pin the sides in place & stitch sides with a straight stitch.
- Overlock or zigzag stitch raw edges on the inside.
- Turn pillow RS out and press seams.
