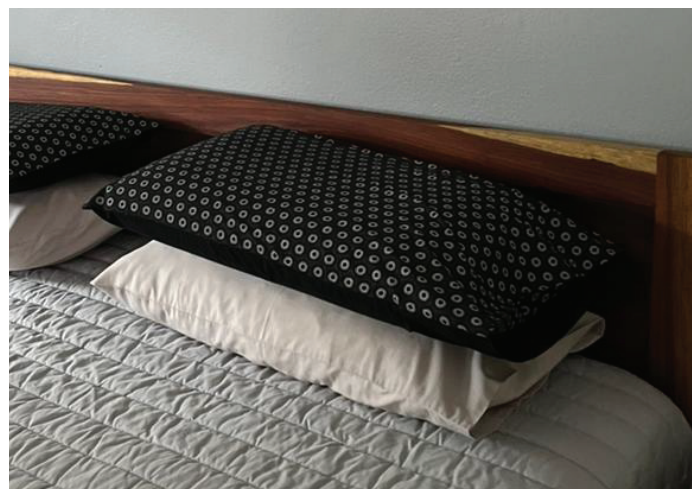

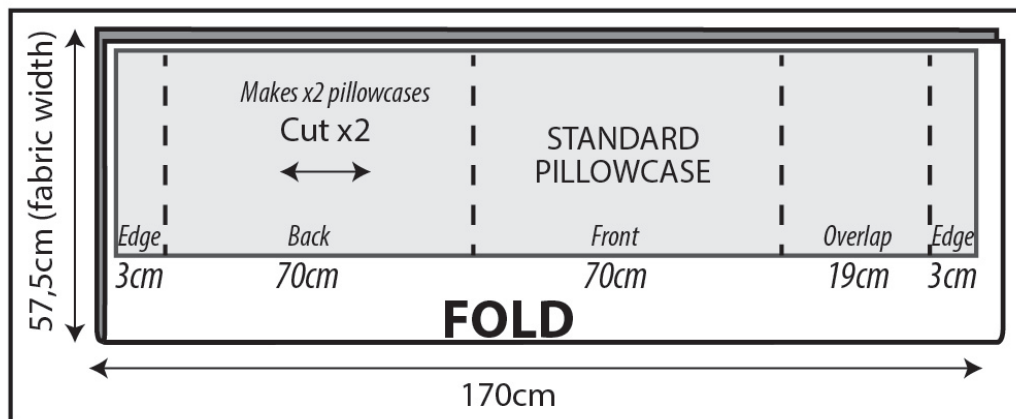
Standard Pillowcase

Materials:

- 1,7m X 115cm (1 7/8 yards X 45 inches) Cotton fabric (*Makes x2 pillowcases*)
- Thread in complimentary colour

List of Pattern Pieces:

- 1: Pillowcase

Notes:

- The amount of fabric given makes 2 standard pillow cases.
- Finished pillow case size = 47cm X 70cm (18,5" x 27,5")
- Standard pillow size = 45cm X 70cm (18" x 27,5")
- If you want to make a pillowcase with two different fabrics for the front and back, separate the pattern on the line between the front and back.

Instructions:

- 1) **Pattern:**
 - Cut out pattern and transfer the markings.
- 2) **Finish edges:**
 - Fold edge twice 1.5cm (5/8") (total 3cm (1 1/4")) and stitch close to the seam edge. Repeat with the other side.
- 3) **Stitch pillow:**
 - Fold RS of the back to the RS of the front, aligning at the overlap line (your pillow front and back are RS together).
 - Next fold the RS of the overlap back onto the WS of the back.
 - Pin the sides in place & stitch sides with a straight stitch.
 - Overlock or zigzag stitch raw edges on the inside.
 - Turn pillow RS out and press seams.
